

### The Language Experience Approach

"Struggling readers, regardless of age, have many life experiences that teachers can tap into to create text," (Meyerson, M. J. & Kulesza, D.L., 2010). As a teacher gets to know his or her students and some of their shared life experiences, that knowledge of the students provides grounds for personal writing opportunities. Once students' words have found their way to paper, those words can be read repeatedly in a text that is both approachable and accessible because the students have ownership of the words used. The studentcreated text combines personal experience, personal vocabulary, and newly learned vocabulary that builds on and extends reading proficiency.
