**ILA Conference 2017 in Orlando** 

"Reimagined Engagement and Success for ALL Students through the Language Experience Approach" was the title of our Language Experience Special Interest Group (LESIG) session at the International Literacy Association conference held in Orlando, July of 2017. The variety of round table presentations focused on learners and their literacy needs, while spanning a wide range of ages, grade levels, ability levels, and activities that all represented the Language Experience Approach well. With such diverse applications as training pre-service teachers to select quality children's literature, helping young children and their families develop a sense of place through writing about their shared community trips and experiences, and assisting ELL students in finding their "voices," all of the participants found something that they could take home and use immediately.
